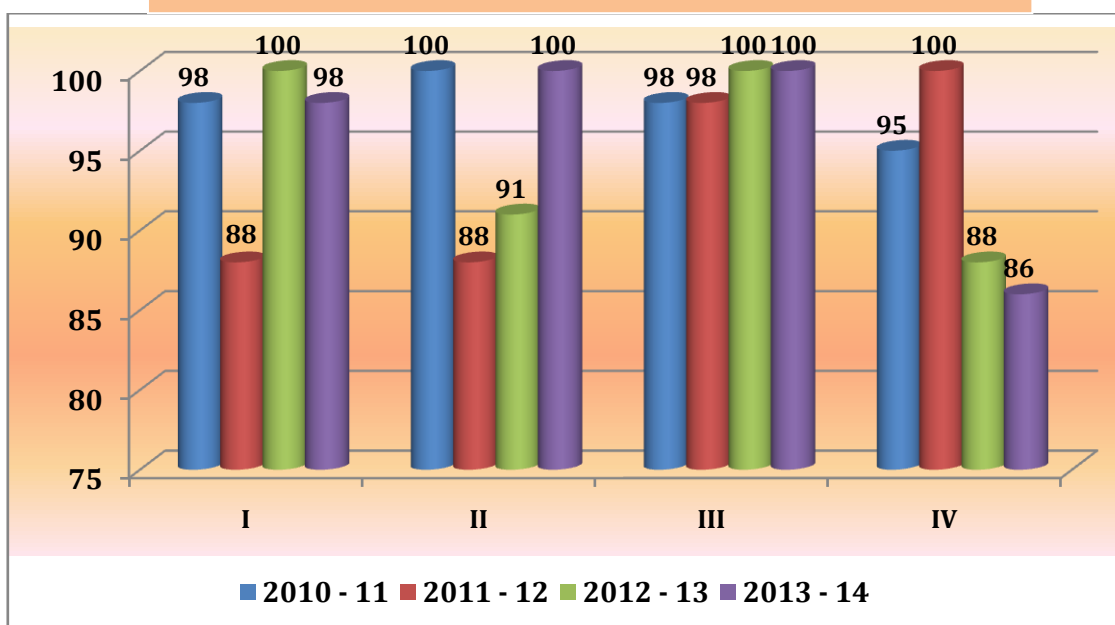

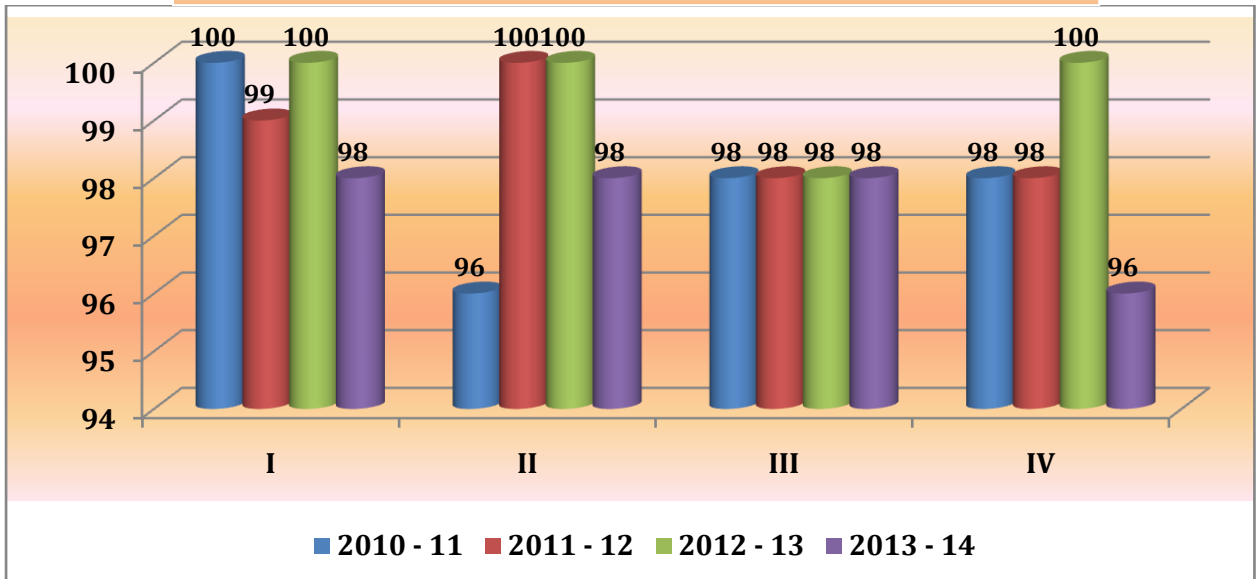

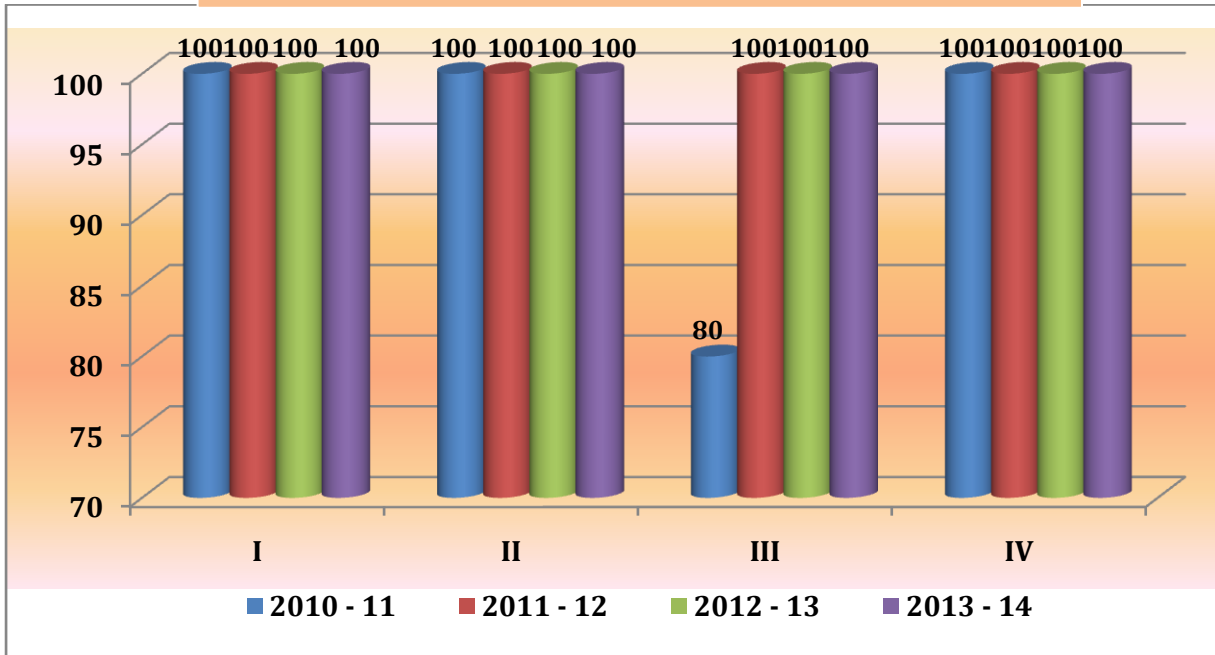

Trends of Success Rate of BCA Students : 2010 - 2014

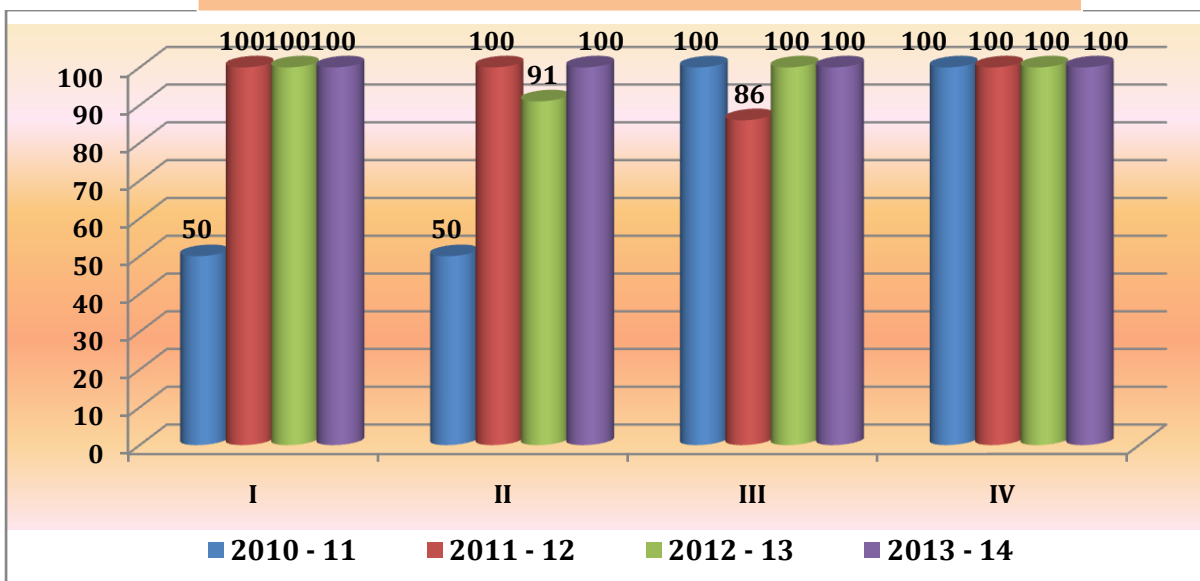

Trends of Success Rate of BBM Students : 2010 - 2014

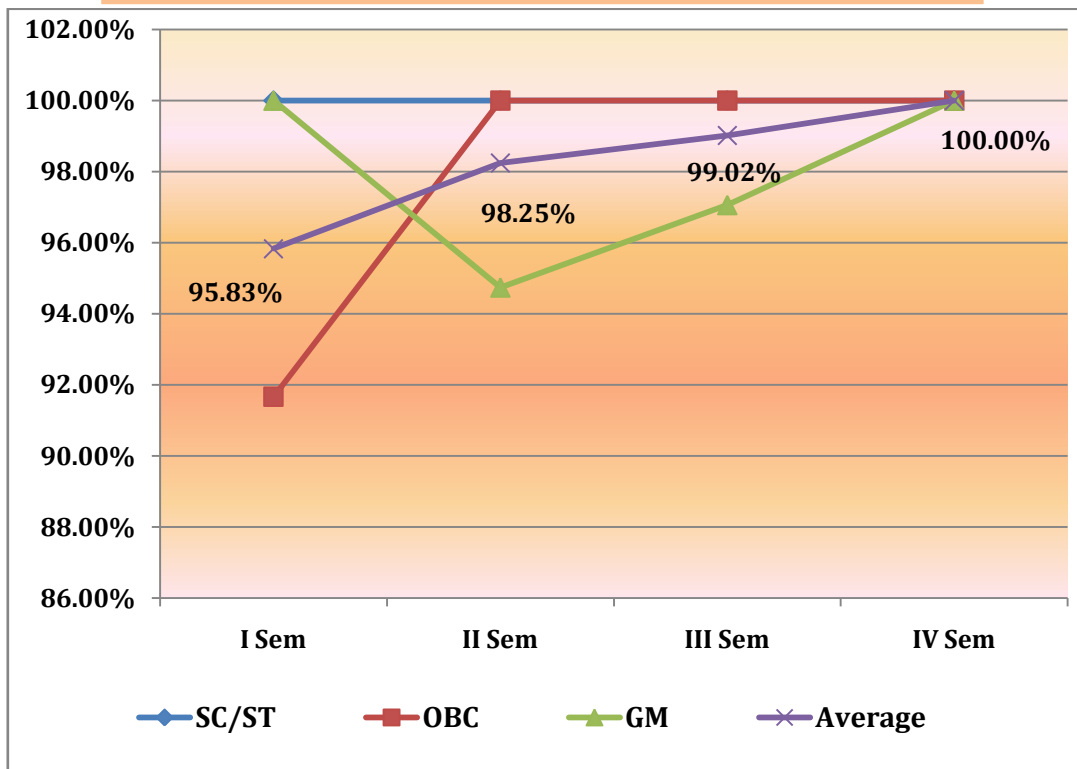

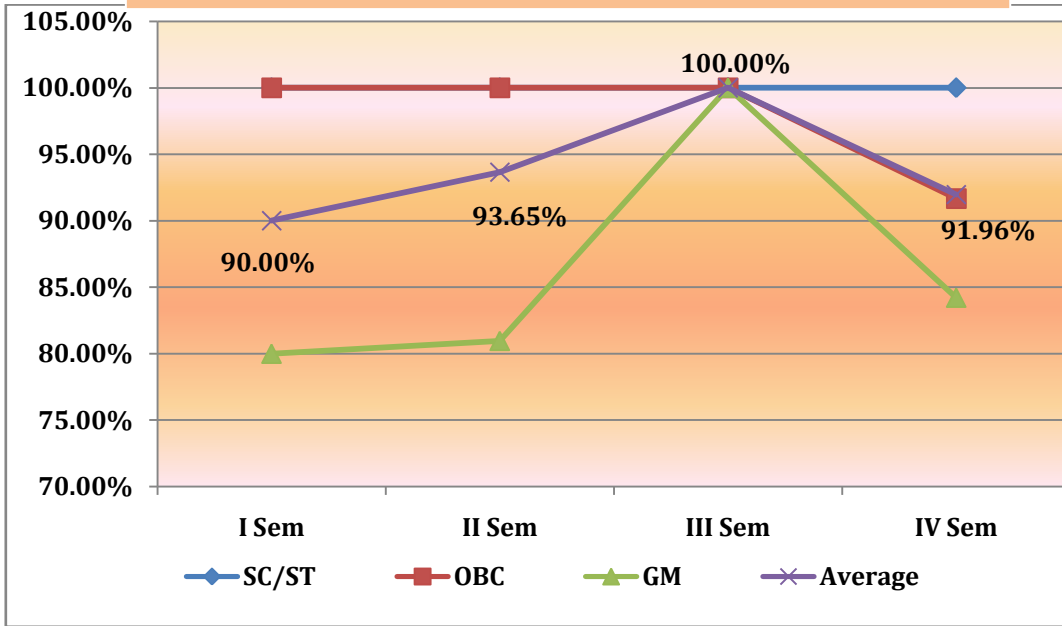

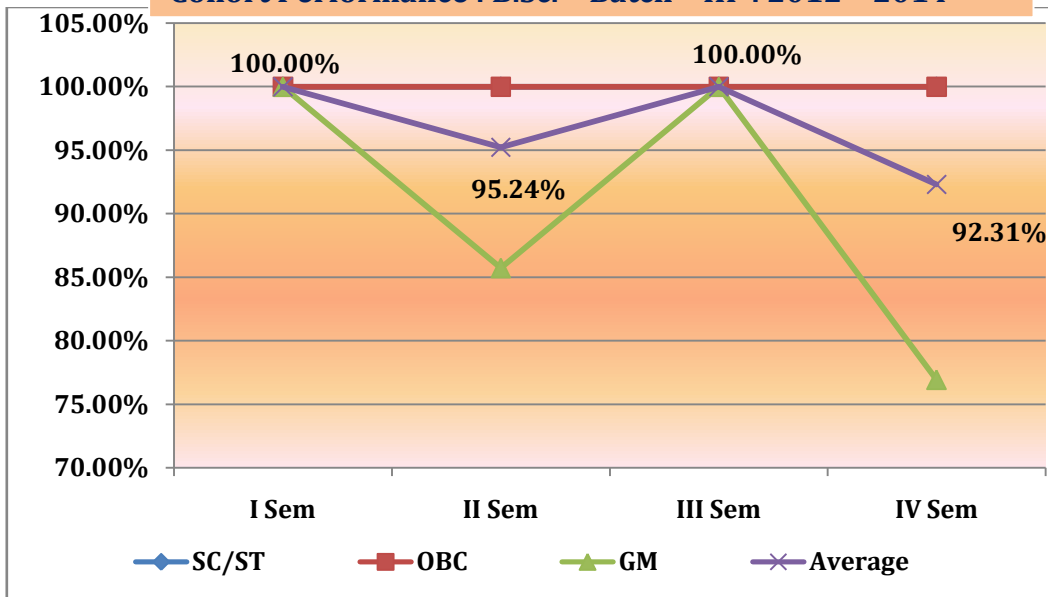
Cohort Performance : B.Sc. - Batch - II : 2011 - 2013

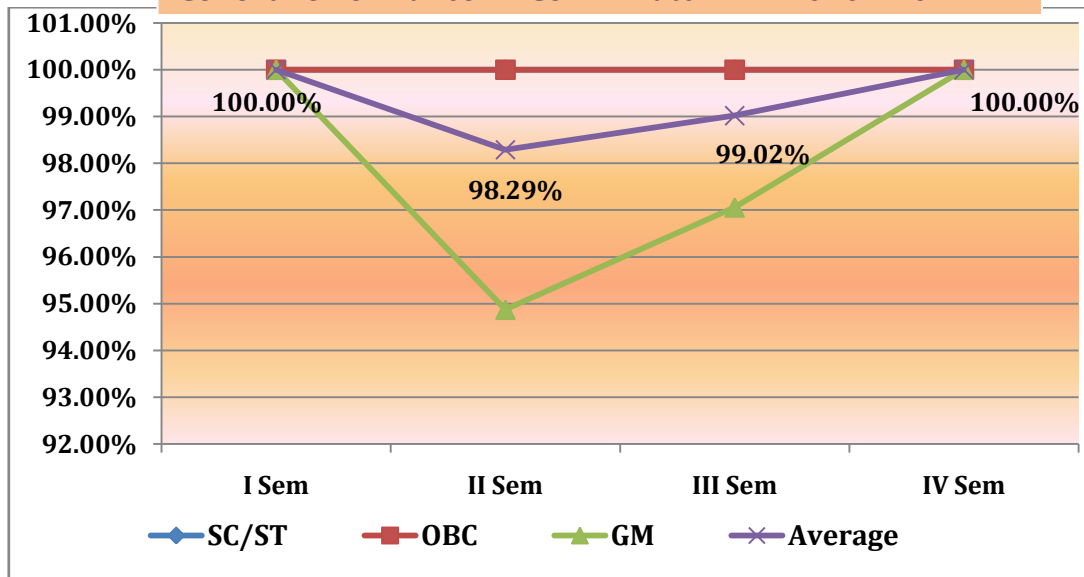

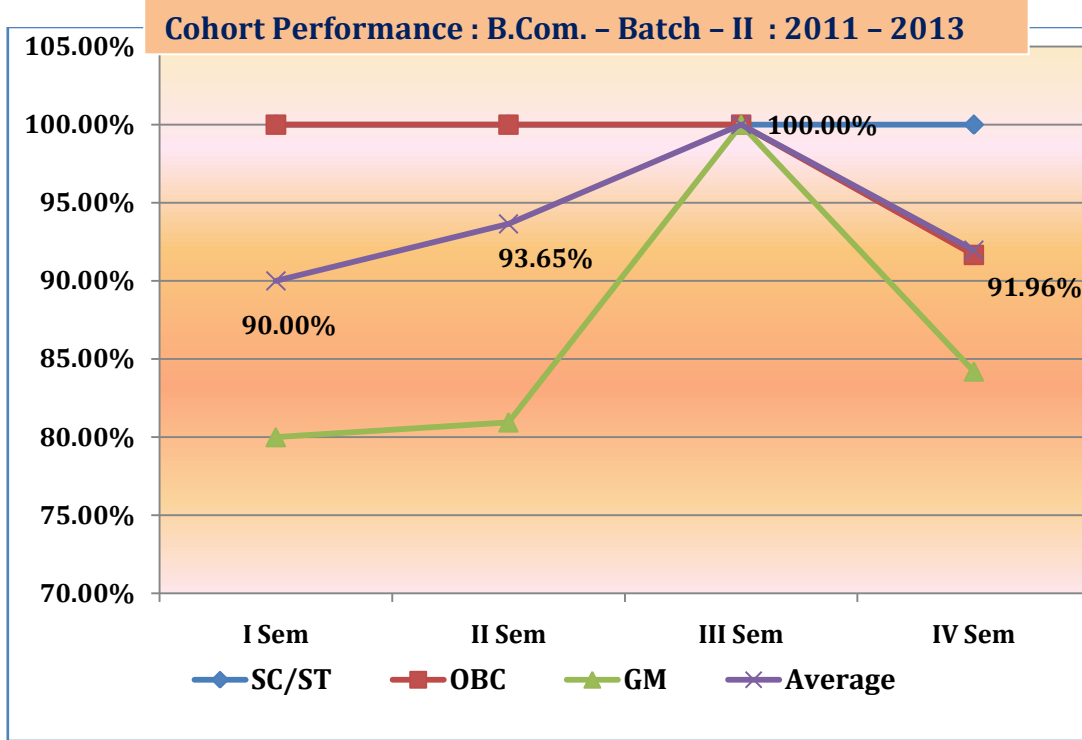

Cohort Performance : B.Com. - Batch - I : 2010 - 2012



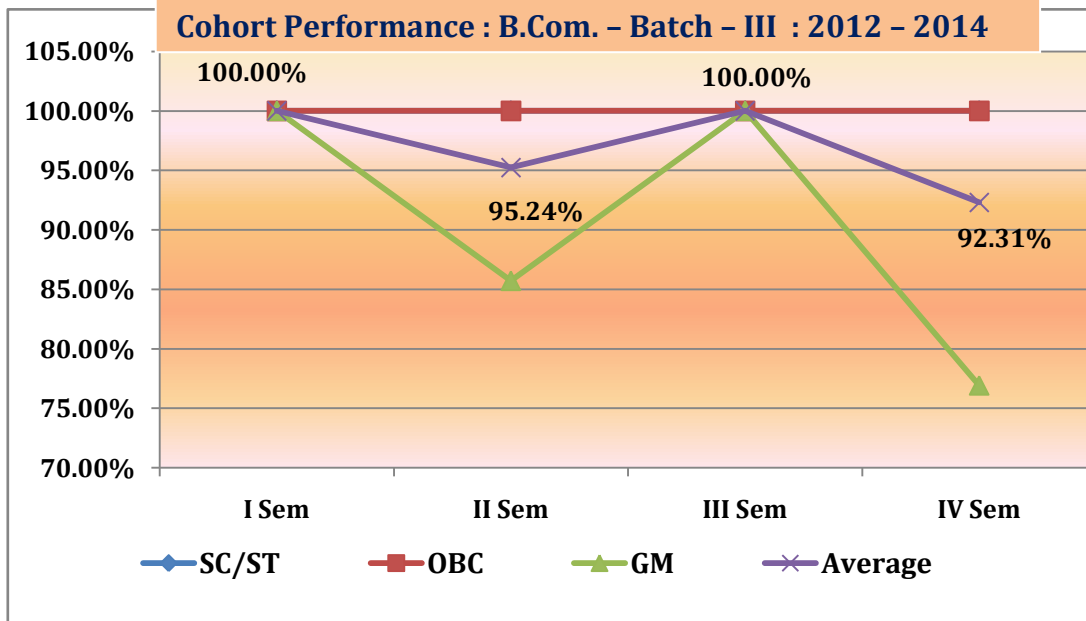

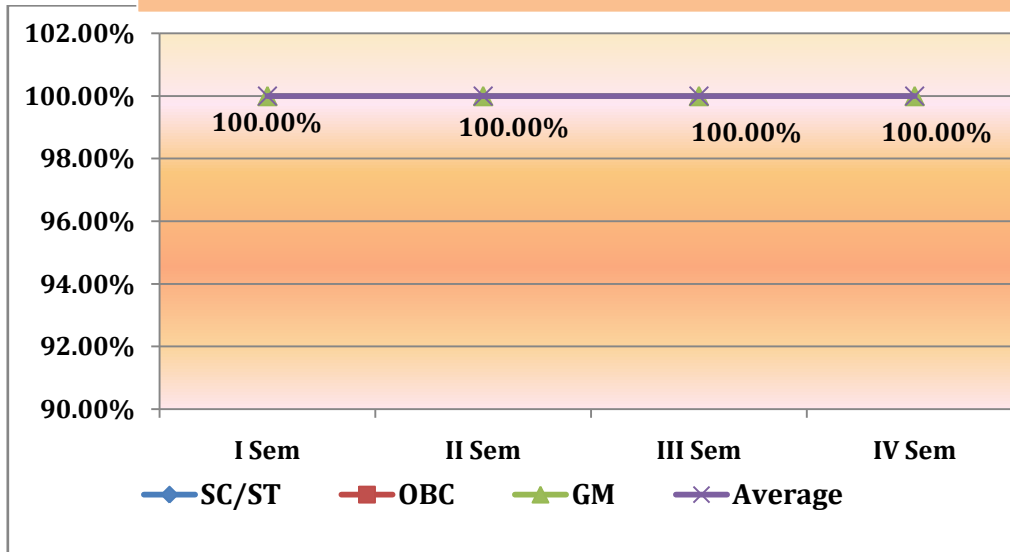

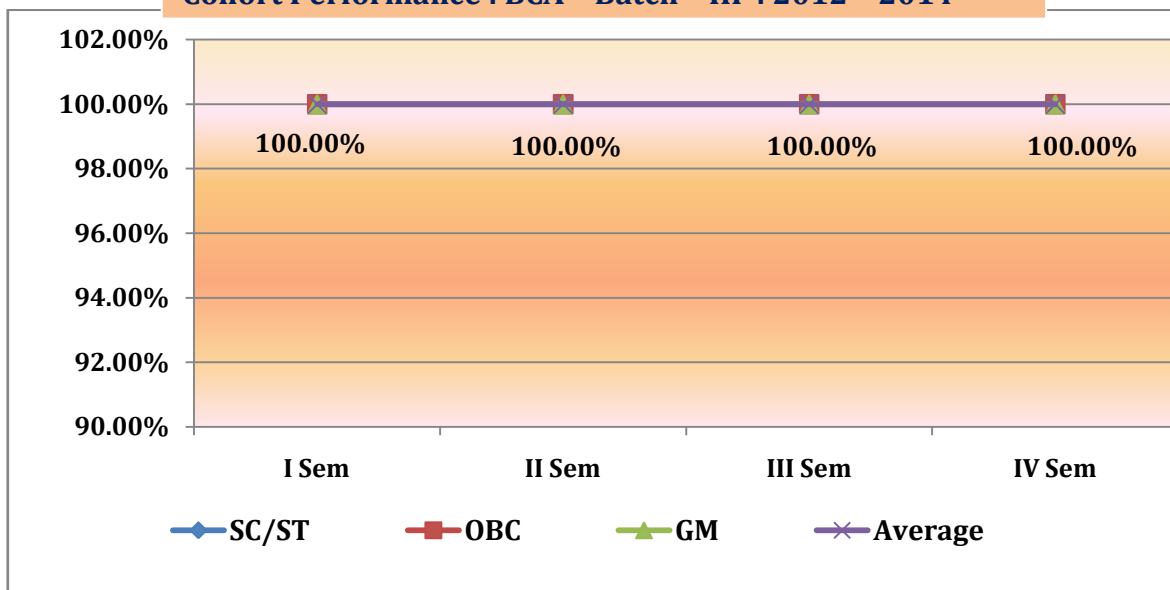
Cohort Performance : BCA – Batch – II : 2011 – 2013

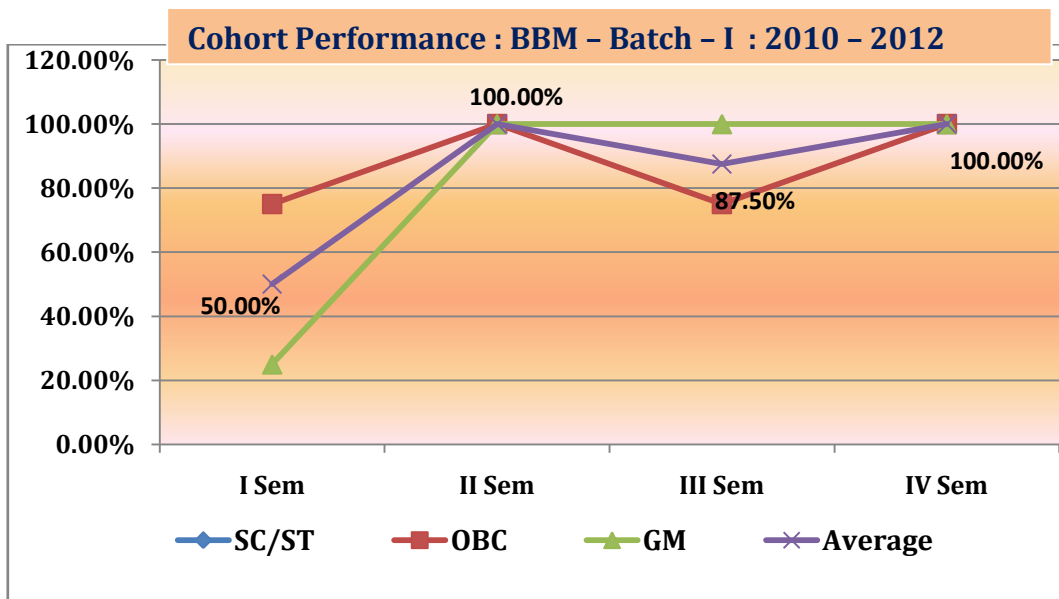
Cohort Performance : BCA – Batch – III : 2012 – 2014

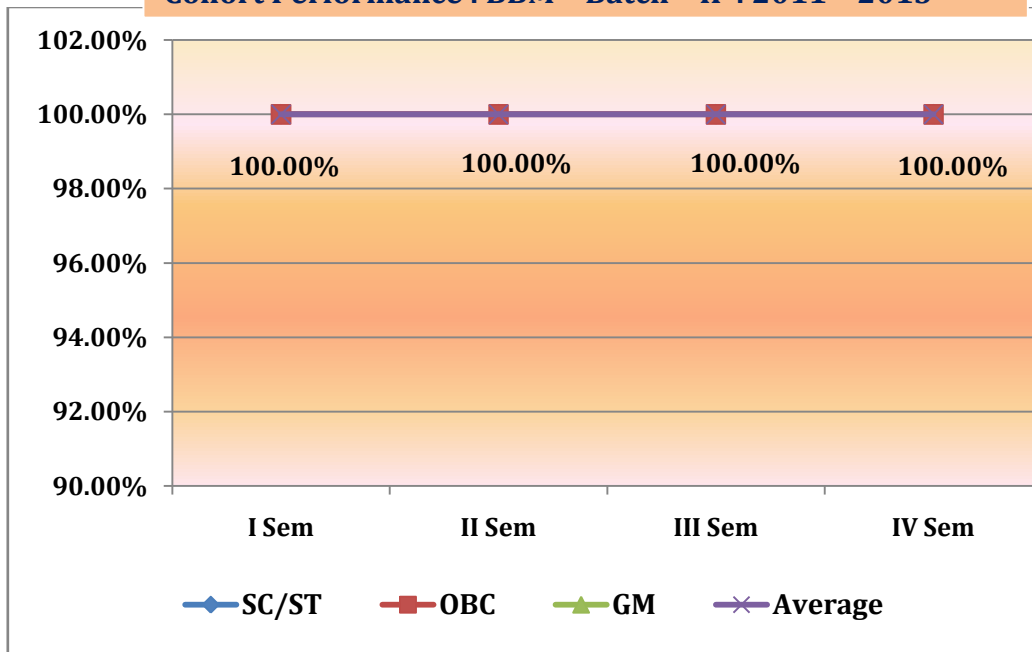

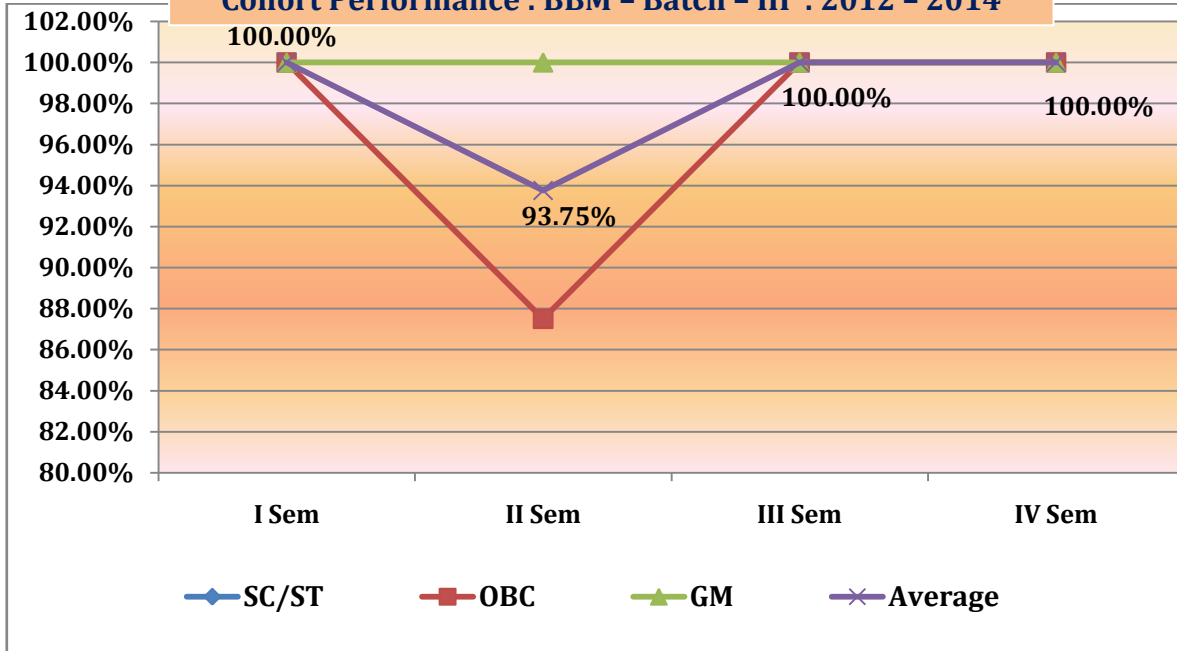
