

#### Trends of Success Rate of Science Students: 2010 - 2014



### **Trends of Success Rate of Commerce Students: 2010 - 2014**




### Trends of Success Rate of BCA Students: 2010 - 2014

### Trends of Success Rate of BBM Students: 2010 - 2014






Cohort Performance: B.Sc. - Batch - I: 2010 - 2012


