

Some of the themes set for World Population Day in the past include Reproductive Health and AIDS in the year 1996, Approaching the six billion in 1998, Saving Women's Lives in 2000, 1,000,000,000 adolescents in 2003, Plan Your Family, Plan Your Future in 2008, 7 Billion Actions in the year 2011, Focus on Adolescent Pregnancy in 2013, Vulnerable Populations in Emergencies in 2015 and Family Planning is a Human Right in 2018. This year a specific theme was not there, but there was emphasis globally on the unmet goals of 1994 International Conference on Population and Development which happened 25 years back in Cairo where 179 governments have adopted that "reproductive health and gender equality for achieving sustainable development".

Roughly 83 million people are being added to the world's population every year. Experts predict that over8.6 billion population in 2030, 9 billion people will walk on the earth in 2050, 11.2 billion in 2100 and that's if fertility rates decrease from their current levels .Out of 7.4 billion people in the world, India is 1.327 billion which approximately 17.5 % of the world population. According to this situation, it is important to understand the need for population control. Approx. 800 women die every day due to pregnancy-related complications and from these 20 percent of the women are from India.

In this context, Vijaya College, R.V. Road, Bengaluru has celebrated the World Population day on 11th July 2019 in College premises through educational sessions, poster making and spread awareness among the students by conducting quiz questionnaires related to population. Students of various classes participated in the session with tremendous enthusiasm.






