Report on Industrial visit 2019 BBA

In the view to fulfill the academic requirement and to bring the students to an exposure to the industrial functions, industrial visit is carried on as and how permissions from the industry is available.

An industrial visit to Hyderabad, Telangana, was organized for BBA students during September 2019 on the 19th & 20th. Forty-seven students had registered their names for the same, and three faculties had joined them. Dr. B. C. Rajkumar of Kannada Department, Prof. A. R. Girish Babu of Commerce Department, Prof. Krupasindhu MD of Department of Management Studies were the faculties in charge for the visit. The journey began from the college premises in the previous night. The destination was reached on the 19th morning, allowing the students to get ready for the visit.

The first visit was made to Hindustan Coca-Cola Beverages Pvt. Ltd, Ameenpur unit, Hyderabad, Telangana. The security staff welcomed the group cordially and directed everyone to the AV room quickly. All were made to view the photographs and the video of the production process. It was a similar process, as is in Bidadi, Karnataka, and Vijayawada of Andhra Pradesh. The plant has the process of distillation of the water into carbon aeration so that it could be mixed with the syrup. This solution was filled in inflated plastic bottles. The process was followed by labeling, packaging, and loading for further distribution. After the video display, the students were taken to the production floor to view the entire process directly. They observed the layout, machines installed, workers, posters, directions and symbols around the floor, and few tips for safety measures like jars of earplugs here and there. The students were provided with juice in the AV room.

The second visit was made straight to the National Institution of Nutrition, Tarnaka Metro Station, Hyderabad, Telangana. It was late afternoon by the time we reached the place. So the staffs were not cooperative in displaying any visuals or introductions about the institution. Everybody was taken to the hall of posters and models. They depicted the importance of nutrition, especially for infants and women in rural areas. The posters contained pictures of diseases and disorders due to lack of nutrition and the pictures of those who were severely affected.

Sir Robert McCarrison founded NIN in the year 1918 as 'Beri-Beri' Enquiry Unit in a single room laboratory at the Pasteur Institute, Coonoor, Tamil Nadu. Within a short span of 7 years, this unit blossomed into a "Deficiency Disease Enquiry' and later in 1928 emerged a full-fledged "Nutrition Research Laboratories" (NRL) with Dr. McCarrison as its first Director. It was shifted to Hyderabad in 1958. At the time of its golden jubilee in 1969, it was renamed as National Institute of Nutrition (NIN)

It was a quick walk around the hall. It was followed by returning to the accommodation, lunch, shopping in and around the Hussain Sagar-Musical fountain show & Boating. 20th September 2019, the second day of the industrial trip was spent entirely at Ramoji Film City. Ramoji Rao
