EDITORIAL WORDS

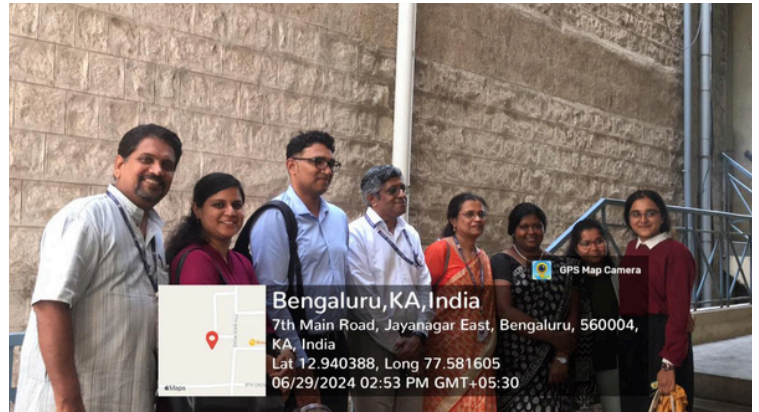
Vijaya reminiscence is a reflection of the effort of students and teachers over the past semester. It is the first half yearly newsletter to be published.

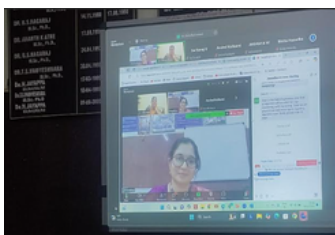
Guest Lecture on 'Idea to Impact'
