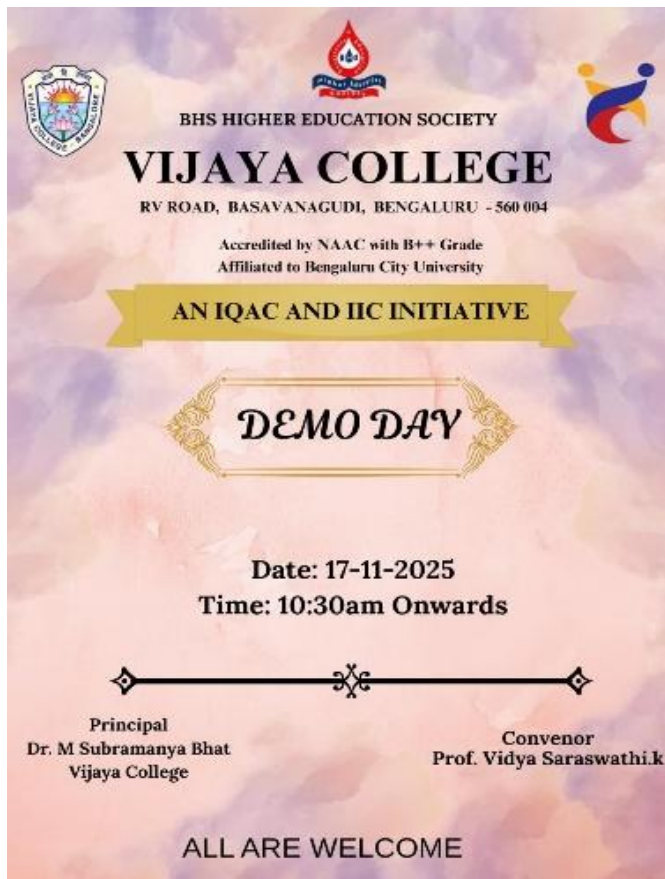
PUC Students actively participated and interacted with the student speakers.

Feedback:

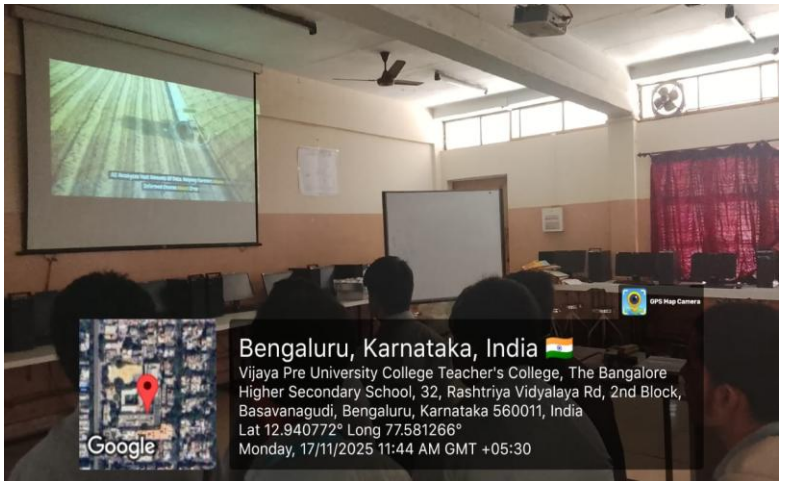
